# **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

## **BP Back Panels**

Thank you for selecting Stern-Williams. To ensure this product is installed properly, please read these instructions carefully before you begin. (Certain installations may require professional help.)



**IMPORTANT:** When installing Stern-Williams Back Panels, observe local plumbing and building codes.

### **PREPARATION**

- NOTE: Before installing the back panels, the mop sink must be installed first.
- Refer to "Rough-In" dimensions and determine where the Stern-Williams back panels will be installed. (See below).
- Ensure the walls where the back panels will sit are free of debris and dry.
- Screws and wall anchors are provided.

#### INSTALLATION

**Note:** If there are multiple panels a corner bracket will also be included. A typical setup will have two panels and the corner bracket as shown in Figure 1.

- 1. Align the panels with the top of the mop sink and mark the mounting hole locations.
  - a. Alignment of the panel should be flush with the top surface of the mop sink and flush with other back panels it meets in the corner.
- 2. Use the provided mounting hardware to secure the back panels.
  - a. The corner bracket fits <u>behind</u> the back panels as shown in Figure 2.
- 3. It is recommended but not required to apply a bead of silicone along the base of the panels along the mop sink and where multiple panels meet.






